An emphasis will be given as to how St. John guides through the dark night of the soul in which we come to a profound experience of God's oneness with us in all things. This retreat is intended for sincere beginners as well as those more experienced in the practice of contemplative prayer. Time will be provided for periods of silent meditation, personal reflection, and discussion of the themes presented.

† Divinization through love: Discovering that God's life is our life.

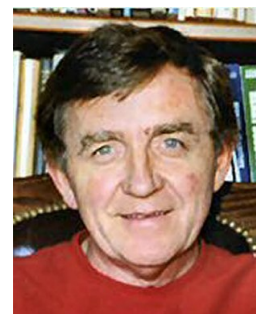

Topic explored in the conferences include:

- † The life of Saint John of the Cross, an introduction to his basic teachings.
- † The night of the senses: the loss of the felt sense of God's presence.
- † The night of the spirit: the darkness of naked faith in which we are transformed in God.
- † The intimacy with God that arises in the dark night of our unconsummated longings.

James Finley, Ph.D. lived as a monk at the cloistered Trappist monastery of the Abbey of Gethsemani in Kentucky, where the world-renowned monk and author, Thomas Merton, was his spiritual director.
