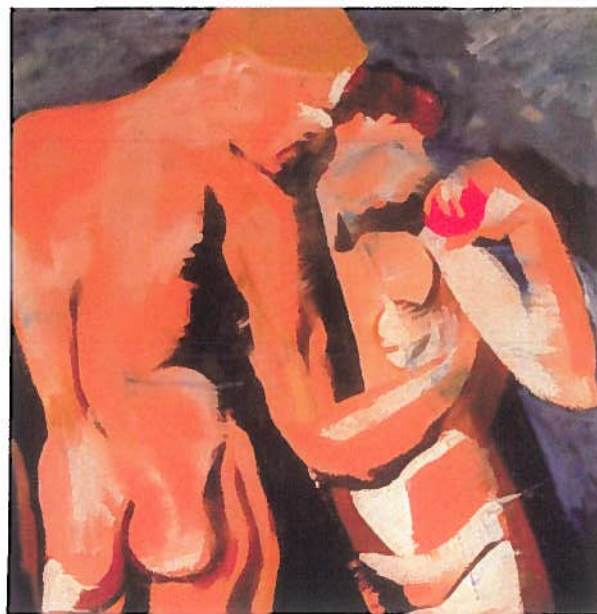


Wounded Lovers

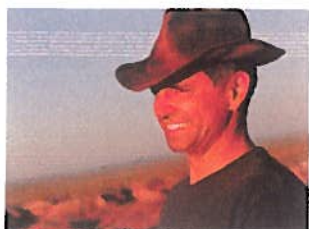
